# Security stepped up in Delhi, markets, temples under vigil

NEW DELHI, OCT. 13

The Delhi police has intensified security across the national capital, including major markets, temples, and other crowdlocations, ahead of Diwali, to ensure the safety of citizens and maintain law and order, officials said on Sunday.

Over 20,000 police and paramilitary personnel have been deployed across the city, it said.

CCTV surveillance, dog squads, and anti-drone measures have also been put in place, while emergency medical services and fire safety teams are stationed at prominent locations to respond swiftly to any untoward incidents.

Special vigilance already being monitored at major markets, temples, and other crowded locations, with multi-layered security arrangements,

Ahead of the festival, the Delhi police conducted a citywide 'general gasht' across all 15 districts on Saturday and Sunday. Senior officers joined reg-

DCP (east) Abhishek Dhania said the general gasht aims to ensure city wide safety, monitor dark and vulnerable areas, check traffic violations, and identify known criminals operating in various localities.

# Harassment row rocks AIIMS, head of cardiac dept removed

AIIMS-Delhi has removed Dr A.K. Bisoi as the head of the cardio thoracic and vascular surgery (CTVS) department, pending an inquiry into a complaint of harassment against him by a female nursing

According to sources, the AIIMS Nurses Union had filed a com-plaint with the AIIMS director and the Prime Minister's Office alleging workplace intimidation and sexual harassment, and repeated use of "vulgar, unprofessional and derogatory language" by Dr Bisoi targeting the female staff.

The AIIMS administration has handed over the charge of the CTVS department to senior professor Dr V. Devagourou with immediate effect.

30.09.2025 received from a female nursing officer of the Department of CTVS against Dr A.K. Bisoi, professor and HoD of CTVS, and the representations in that regard received from the AIIMS Nurses Union dated 30/09/2025, 04/10/2025, and 07/10/2025, the Director has assigned the charge of Head of the Dept of CTVS to Dr V. Devagourou, Professor of CTVS, with immediate effect, till further orders," an AIIMS memorandum issued on October 11 said.

The AIIMS Nurses Union, in the complaint to the PMO on October 9,

## 'Autoimmune disorders affect 7 in 10 India women'

Leading rheumatologists have revealed that nearly 70 per cent of people living with autoimmune diseases are women. During a special session on women's health and autoimmune disorders, rheumatologists highlighted that the fem ale immune system, though stron ger in fighting infections, can som etimes turn against the body itself, leading to autoimmune diseases.

Autoimmune disorders occur when the body's defence system, which usually protects against infections, mistakenly attacks its own tissues. Common conditions include rheumatoid arthritis, lupus, thyroiditis, psoriasis, and Sjögren's syndrome.

Speaking at the 40th annual conference of the Indian Rheumato logy Association (IRACON 2025), Dr Uma Kumar, the head of

rheumatology at AIIMS, said, "In my outpatient clinic at AIIMS, almost seven out of every 10 patients with autoimmune diseases are women. We see a clear pattern — women often come late because they overlook persistent symptoms. Genetic make-up, hormonal changes during reproductive age and after childbirth, combined with stress, obesity, and nutritional deficiencies, can make them more vulnerable to autoimmune diseases. It's time we recognised autoimmune disorders as a major women's health issue in India." Highlighting the need for focused policies, conference chairman Dr Rohini Handa, senior consultant at Indraprastha Apollo Hospitals, said, "Autoimmune diseases are as common as diabetes or heart disease, yet they get far less attention. When 70 per cent of those affected are women, we can't treat it as a gender-neutral issue.
